

Luciana Dini is full professor of Comparative Anatomy and Cytology at the department of Biology and Biotechnology, Sapienza, University of Rome. She was the director of the international Master "Electron Mycroscopy: a tool for industrial quality and environmental monitoring" and of the academic Master of 1° level "Data manager in oncologia: esperto nella progettazione e sperimentazione clinica" of the University of Salento. At the same University, she was Faculty of Science delegate of the Erasmus/Socrates program, member of the Senato Accademico and the Committee of the Research for area 05.

She is the national Coordinator of the Board of the Full professors of SSD BIO/06.

She is member of National and International Scientific Societies covering different corporate offices.

She was invited speakers to many National and International Conferences, in particular to the prestigious GORDON RESEARCH CONFERENCE, and she has organized National and International Conferences and European Schools. She is PI of numerous research projects. She wrote more than 200 research papers and books.

She is cited in the volumes "Who'sWho in Science and Engineering" and "2000 outstanding scientists of the 21st century". She was granted in the 1987 by the " Società Nazionale di Scienze Lettere ed Arti" in Napoli as best young scientist, in the 2003 and 2005 received the "Gold medal" by the University of Yerevan (Armenia). In the 2005 she received by the *Medical State University of Yerevan (Armenia) the Medicine Degree ad honorem*.
