Its expertise area covers resistance and defensive mechanisms of crops against parasitic plants and other pathogens, nanotechnology applied to plant research and agriculture, effect of beneficial microbes (mycorrhizal fungi and rhizobacteria) on crops, plant histology and microscopy (histochemistry, confocal laser scanning microscopy) studies.
