

Prof. Giovanni Neri is Full Professor of *Chemistry* at the Dept. of Engineering, University of Messina. He has been invited researcher/professor at the College of Chemical Engineering, The University of Michigan (1991 and 1996), at University of Alagappa (2013) and Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Indore (2016). From 2004 to 2007 he has been Head of the Department of Industrial Chemistry and Materials Engineering of the University of Messina. He is in the Steering Committee of AISEM (Italian Association of Sensors and Microsystems) and President elect 2016-2019 of the American Nano Society (ANS) Italy section. He is Associate Editor-in-Chief of *Chemosensors*, member of the Editorial Board of *Sensors* and Academic Editor for the “*Gas Sensors*” topical collection. He is author of more than 300 papers in international journals with > 9500 citations and h-index 54 (*Google-Scholar*). In 2013 he has been awarded a grant by Samsung SAIT Global Research Outreach program for the project “Smart sensors for breath analysis”.
